Dear Parents, There are two big announcements in this post:

1. The School Board has officially hired Mrs. Celia Ingle for the 5th/6th grade home room position beginning August of 2022. Mrs. Ingle has been a part of the Trinity family for many years, wearing many different hats, and we are excited to see her join the full-time staff. This also means we will have an opening for a part-time PreSchool Teacher next year. Additionally, we are looking to add Classroom Aid positions, along with a Special Education Teacher and School Counselor. These positions are all made possible through our EANS funding and will be paid through the State of Missouri. Days/times are flexible. Current staff and families who are interested in applying for any of these positions should let me know by March 14.

2. In the summer of 2020, our school board made the decision to temporarily move to a 4-day week to help our school weather the COVID-19 Pandemic. After two years with the 4-day week, a parent/staff survey was sent out and it received 48 responses. The school board reviewed all input and discussed it in great depth at the February meeting. A few concerns were raised, but the overwhelming response to the survey was in favor of a 4-day week and it was officially adopted by the school board at the meeting on February 24. The 2022-23 School Calendar was also adopted and it is available at www.trinity1874.com/parents. In response to the concern raised in the survey regarding the need for school care on Mondays: school care is available this year and will continue to be offered to those who need it on Mondays when school is not in session. We strive to meet the needs of our families and if you are in need of school care on a Monday, please let the office or Ms. Layna Essary know. In response to the concern raised in the survey regarding enough time to cover curriculum: school leadership shares in that concern and now that the 4-day week has been officially adopted, we will be taking much-needed time to review and revise our grade-level curriculum. Our teachers will be meeting throughout the summer and several days have been set aside for teacher curriculum work days in the 22-23 calendar. These days will be dedicated to aligning our grade level expectations to ensure we are delivering a complete, comprehensive curriculum and a smooth transition from grade to grade. We are committed to continue the long-standing educational excellence that Trinity is known for in the community. ~Mrs. M





2022-23 ENROLLMENT

Reserve your space now for the 2022-23 school year. Our seats will be open first to students and siblings of students who are currently enrolled and we will close re-enrollment to current students on March 16. Several classes are currently at capacity, so be sure to reserve your spot. To do this, log into Fast Direct and scroll to the bottom of the landing page where you will see a RED RE-ENROLLMENT BUTTON. If you are on your cell phone, look for the registration tab. If you have any trouble, be sure to contact the office. Please note that all PreSchool and PreKindergarten students are automatically rolled over to Kindergarten by default. Go ahead and complete the re-enrollment and we will adjust the EC classes from the office. If you have a sibling that is not currently enrolled, but will be next year (like for PreSchool), contact the office BEFORE MARCH 16 to have their name added to the roster and reserved for next year. On March 21, all open spots will be offered to the community and to those already on a wait list.





OUTSTANDING BALANCES

Please check your tuition, registration, lunch, and school care balances each month. Lunch and school care balances should be under \$100 and tuition/registration should be current in order to re-enroll for 2022-23. Make arrangements by contacting the office if you have any outstanding balances and you would like to re-enroll.

CONFERENCES


Conferences are March 15-18 (except PreKinder, which is in late March). If you have any concerns about your child's progress and would like to schedule a conference, contact the school office.


ACCREDITATION
