Printed Name_____ Date Please be aware that certain procedures performed in our office are not included in the standard office visit. As an otolaryngologist (ENT), Dr. Schleimer has equipment available which allows for evaluation not available in other healthcare settings. Dr. Schleimer will only perform these procedures when deemed medically necessary to best diagnose and treat our patients. If you are presenting with a nasal disorder, throat/voice complaint, or hearing loss, there is a good chance Dr. Schleimer will need to perform one or more of the following procedures. These procedures will be billed separately and in addition to office visit charges. Depending on your health plan, you may have some financial liability for diagnostic studies performed in our office. Be assured that we are following accepted billing and coding guidelines. Due to the large number of insurance plans accepted, we are unable to provide plan-specific coverage information regarding the following procedures. Please contact your insurance provider to verify benefits and coverage information prior to having any services rendered. Ear Wax Removal(CPT 69210) — Ear Wax Removal is a treatment that safely extracts excess ear wax by carefully removing the blockage with a curette (a delicate and atraumatic tool). Fiberoptic Laryngoscopy(CPT 31575) — This diagnostic procedure utilizes a flexible camera, enabling a thorough internal examination of the throat, vocal cords, and the surrounding tissues. To prepare the patient for examination, topical anesthetic is applied to the throat. The camera is then inserted through the nostril, before being positioned for a full view of the throat and larynx. Most patients consider the procedure to be painless. <u>Microscopic Ear Examination(CPT 92504)</u> This short and painless examination is conducted with a powerful microscope to enable a full and detailed view of the ear. Nasal Endoscopy(CPT 31231) — This is a minimally invasive diagnostic procedure that enables a thorough examination of the nasal and sinus cavities. A nasal endoscope (a thin tube attached to a camera) is inserted carefully into the nostril to accurately document the condition of the nasal and sinus tissues. Nasal Endoscopy with Debridement (CPT 31237) --- This is a procedure performed after endoscopic sinus surgery. The purpose of the procedure is to remove clot, mucus, debris and ensure polypoid growth has not recurred. By providing my signature below, I authorize Dr. Schleimer to perform the above mentioned procedures when deemed medically necessary and integral to complete Ear, Nose, and Throat evaluation.
