- ¹⁷ Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds.
- ¹⁸ They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart.
- ¹⁹ They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity.
- ²⁰ But that is not the way you learned Christ!—
- ²¹ assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus,

Romans 5: 17-21

Grace Basics: Freedom

- ¹⁸ Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.
- ¹⁹ For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.
- ²⁰ Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,
- ²¹ so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
