






# Monday, January 15 at 10 a.m. online only Dreamkeepers Panel Addresses Gun Violence

#### **ROADMAP TO HOPE - JANUARY 14**

#### Message: "'Where there's a will, there's a way' Power: The Way of Hope"

Psalm 42:11 "Why am I discouraged? Why am I restless? I trust you, Lord! And I will praise you again because you help me, and you are my God.

Science tells us that the way we think powerfully impacts the way we live. We are what we think, and if we find a way to focus on hope, we will find more meaning in life. Today we consider and assess what robs us of our hope and seek to find a way back to it.

#### Engagement Activity: WillPower

Reflect on your why. What makes this goal so important to you?

Connect to Gratitude: Practicing gratitude increases optimism, which contributes to more willpower. List five things you're grateful for.

Accountability partner: Name someone with whom you can share your goal -- someone who can support & encourage you.

Close your eyes and imagine, as vividly as you can, that your goal is achieved. Write a sentence describing how it feels.

### WayPower

Refine your goal. Break it into small steps to make it easier to identify pathways.

Use your network of friends and family. Share your goal with someone in your network and ask for advice on how you might be able to achieve it. Don't immediately judge their advice. Simple listen, say thank you, and record their advice here (you can decide whether or not to follow their advice later):

WWJD? Think...what would Jesus, or Carolyn, or someone else that you know and respect, do in pursuit of the goal you have in mind?
