CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

Consignment: The Consignor will retain 55% of the sale of the merchandise on consignment and The Maker's Market will retain 45%.

5% of the retainage will be used to pay processing fees for card payments and advertising.

Acceptance of merchandise for sale is at the discretion of The Maker's Market. Consignor agrees to deliver merchandise in clean condition and ready to be sold, wrinkle free, no missing parts, and no bad smells. Merchandise is accepted for consignment for a period of 90 days; a price reduction will be made periodically at the discretion of The Maker's Market. If the item does not sell within the 90-day period, the item will be removed from the shop floor, and the consignor will be notified to pick up the item. Any items left at the shop after 30 days of the notification will be donated.

The Maker's Market is not responsible for any loss that occurs due to theft or any other reason and does not insure inventory or personal property for potential losses.

Payments: The cut-off date for processing sales is at close of business on the last business day of the month. Checks to consignors may be picked up on the 10th of the following month. If the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday the checks are available the next business day. Once checks are written, you have 45 days to pick them up or they will be voided. Only consignors will be allowed to remove unsold items or pick up checks.

Prohibited Items:

- Damaged, dirty or worn out used items
- Counterfeit items
- Mattresses
- Electronic devices that don't work
- Sexually explicit items
- Weapons and other items that endorse or incite violence

Marketing/Advertising: Consignors are encouraged to use any means at their disposal to promote and advertise The Maker's Market. By doing so, every Consignor will be more successful and profitable. Emphasizing the importance of supporting small businesses and local entrepreneurs is our goal!
