NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM SUCH ALTERATION OF SPECIFICATIONS. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the officials. Their decision is final.

- **NO PASSENGERS!**

- *Exception is for the youth class. Youth drivers may be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian ONLY as their passenger and must provide this information at the time of signing in. In no way shape or form as the youth's passenger are you allowed to control, assist, maneuver, etc any component of the vehicle. If you are caught, the driver will be disqualified.

- Any front wheel drive vehicle 1980 & newer (No full-size cars or full frames)
- All cars **MUST** have a roof sign visible.
- You are allowed (2) 4" x 6" and no more than ¼" thick RECTANGULAR patch plates.
- These patch plates CANNOT be cut down (ex- (2) 2" x 3" patched from one 4" x 6" plate).
- These (2) patch plates will be good for all shows.
- **YOUTH CLASS:** The youth class is a beginner class. If you have ran in a regular class with adults, you will no longer be allowed to come back to the youth class to run.
- **YOUTH DRIVERS:** you will need to bring either your birth certificate, permit, license, or state ID to be able to register for the Youth Class. This still applies even if you have already pre-registered.
- Inspection start time will be listed on our website. All drivers must be REGISTERED no later than 2 hours to event start time or will have to pay a \$100 late fee. **PLAN ACCORDINGLY!**
- Any car NOT STICKED by no later than 1 hour to event start time will have to pay a \$100 late fee to be able continue inspection process. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

GENERAL CAR PREP & SAFETY

1. Strip all flammable materials from car. Dash may stay in car.
2. Gas Tank may be left in factory position as long as it is mounted in front of rear axle. Please check factory straps for security. Prefer you leave factory gas tank under vehicle. Gas tank may be moved to back seat area. If mounted to cage must be a minimum of a 4-inch gap to any surrounding sheet metal. Must be **SECURELY** mounted & covered. **Absolutely NO Milk crates**

to hold down batteries or gas cans!!! No bungee cords as tie downs!! Safety first!! **Gas Tank protector MAY be as high as speaker deck vertically. Must be 90 degrees up and down, with no angles whatsoever. GTP and gussets must remain 4" from any sheet metal.**

3. Electrical fuel pump (On/Off) switch must be clearly marked.
4. Front windshield must have bar, chain or wire to prevent hood from entering driver's area. From windshield to firewall/dash cowl only.
5. Battery must be moved to front floorboard area securely mounted and covered. One battery only.
6. **Completely** remove air bag assembly. No paint or spray foam allowed on frame.
7. **Absolutely no spray foam around radiator or on frame. Wires and ECM ok.**

BODY

1. Driver's door **must be painted white** & may be wired, chained, or welded solid and/or may have a steel driver's door skin securely fastened. All other doors welded (**3 spots on vertical door seam, 3" square plates**), or chained or wired in (3) spots only.
2. You **MUST** have a **mandatory** door plate if you do not have a cage.
3. Door plate must be bolted or welded on securely, no more than 6" past door seams.
4. You may wire top of doors to top of car. One spot per door/window opening (3) wraps max or (1) 3"x 3".
5. Hoods may be tied down with (6) 2"x2" angle welded to hood and fenders with half inch bolt **-OR-** (6) spots of #9 wire only allowed.
6. Trunk lid, hatch, gate & hood may be wired shut or bolted with 1/2" bolts in (6) places.
7. 10" hole in hood and trunk for inspection.
8. Creasing **allowed**. Quarters must stay vertical.
9. Engine and Transmission must remain factory to that make of car (ie: Toyota - Toyota, GM - GM, etc)
10. You MAY run aftermarket shifter, aftermarket brake and gas pedals, and aftermarket steering column.
11. Headers are allowed, but not reinforce the car in any way.

BUMPER

1. Loaded factory car bumper or you can change bumper to any automobile 1/4" replica **CAR** bumper. No Chrysler pointy bumpers allowed. DEC and SMW 1/8" bumpers allowed. Call to get bumpers approved.
2. Bumpers may be welded on.
3. You may seam weld bumpers.
4. Bumper may be no wider than the width of front tires.
5. **Crush boxes may be cut, but no further back than core support.**
6. Do not alter factory frames.
7. You may use a 4"x4" or 2"x6" flat tube must have skin of a factory car bumper. No Chrysler pointy bumpers allowed. May have a 4" point tapered over 36". **Square tubed bumpers MUST be capped and rounded on ends.**
8. **HONDA'S ONLY-** for 90-97 Honda's, a spacer may be added to the **END** of the frame rail going forward (toward bumper) to attach it forward of the core support. Nothing may be going backwards in the frame. *Call for clarifications.

CAGE

1. A 4-bar floating cage allowed around driver's compartment.
2. Driver's door plate allowed from cage to rocker (door seam to door seam). Driver's door ONLY.
3. No bigger than 4" x 4" square tube.
4. Side bars may be used with 2"x6" tubing.
5. Side bars 60" MAX and must be 4" from sheet metal.
6. No down legs.
7. Roll over bar may extend off cage vertically. Do not lean back.
8. If you don't have a cage, then a door plate/bar is Mandatory. *****YOUTH DRIVERS MUST have a door plate for both passengers if you choose to have a passenger, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
9. Cage can be inside the door no more than 1" past inside door seam.

SUSPENSION

1. Factory suspension, no changes allowed, **MUST** bounce!
2. Strut Risers allowed.

TIRES/WHEELS

1. Any wheel and tire.

*CLEAN UP RULE MODIFICATIONS

1. (6) patch plates max.

"IF IT DOESN'T SAY YOU CAN, THEN YOU CAN'T."!!!!

Drivers only allowed in inspection area; no other crew allowed. You will pre-pay before inspection. If, your car does not pass inspection **NO Refunds!**

Drivers must wear DOT helmet, eye protection, long pants, long sleeve shirt and closed toed shoes. Fire Suits are always recommended, but not required. Helmets stay on the entire time in car. Only get out of car if told ok to do so.

Drivers must make an aggressive hit every 60 seconds.

This is a beginner class intended for fun. Doing more to your car will be subject to disqualification. Inspector's decisions are final.

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
