



## Modified Power Wheels Rules

Registration available in person before the event.

1. Any power wheel is permitted in this class. **Except small cars, dune racers or anything without sides. Must provide your own power wheel.**
2. Must use a Power Wheel gearbox and motors. 2wd only!! **No live axle swaps or mobility scooter motors.**
3. Any tire combination as long as no studs or metal tires.
4. Bumper swaps are allowed must be wood or plastic. If they are deemed excessive they may need to be cut and or covered so be prepared to make changes. May use metal to mount bumpers. **No splitting wedge type bumpers. Pointy replicas are allowed but must not be a wedge. If you have questions, ask don't assume it is allowed.**
5. You may alter the ride height by raising the front or lowering the back. **Don't get carried away.** Must not be higher than a stock jeep door. **Please ask if you have questions.**
6. Doors and hoods should be secured so they do not come open. Bungy cord, duct tape, or zip ties are recommended.
7. Maximum of 3 batteries allowed. 10ah maximum per batteries!!!! This can be drill batteries. Maximum 40-volt system voltage. Will have meter to check at motors.
8. Aftermarket shifter and wiring allowed.
9. This will be a timed event 20 minutes or if only one is left running in time limit.
10. All children must remain in their power wheel during the event. If they leave the power-wheel, they are subject to disqualification.
11. You may decorate your power wheel to look like a demolition derby car.
12. Tech has the final say. No arguing if you can't fix the issue, you will not run.

Awards will be given out at the conclusion of the event.
