



## Stock Power Wheels Rules

Registration available in person before the event.

1. This is supposed to be fun for the kids, parents, and spectators. No modification to the power wheel other than stated below.
  2. You must provide your own power wheel vehicle.
  3. All kids must be accompanied by an adult during the event.
  4. Power wheels need to be the kind the child **sits IN not ON**. Must have leg protection. No tractors, 4-wheelers, Motorcycles, 4wd or Monster trucks (this includes but not limited to grave diggers etc.) allowed.
  5. Child must always wear a helmet while on track. Bicycle helmets will be allowed. Long sleeve shirts, long pants, closed toe shoes and elbow pads are not required but strongly recommended.
  7. Doors and hoods should be secured so they do not come open. Bungy cord, duct tape, or zip ties are recommended.
  8. Seat belts are not mandatory but recommended.
  9. You may decorate your power wheel to look like a demo derby car. Only non-metallic pieces may be used such as cardboard, tape, paint etc. Absolutely NO additions may be made to reinforce the power wheel. Anything deemed excessive will be removed or you will not run in this class.
  10. All power wheels must sit like the store-bought ones. NO raising or lowering of the front or the rear of the power wheel.
  11. Stock battery can be replaced with up to a 12-volt lawnmower battery or one drill battery 20 volt max. It can be positioned anywhere inside the car except for the passenger seat. It must be secured and covered. Aftermarket shifter and wiring allowed.
  12. You may not add rubber tire to the tread for added traction. No screws, Velcro, or anything else may be attached to the tires for added traction.
  13. All children must remain in their power wheel during the event. If they leave the power wheel, they are subject to disqualification.
- Tech has the final decision if the power wheel will pass. No arguing this decision. You can move to the modify class or not run.
