




BUDGET NEWS! At the End of the first 'quarter' of 2025, we are in need of 'catching' up with general expenses at Laidlaw. We have been privileged to receive grant money to make improvements, but that money is designated, and we need to also 'keep up with the day to day'. GRANT PROGRESS: A Grant from the Ontario Anti-Hate Program of \$7,500.00 has facilitated installation of Cameras all around the church, and some additional funds beyond the cost of cameras will be used to secure windows and doors. The new cameras are now up and running. If you would like to have access to the cameras on your phone, speak to Rev. Doug. A Grant of \$28,000.00 from the Hamilton Presbytery Mission Council is helping to create the 'Upper Room at Laidlaw' This will be a rehearsal and performance space, a lesson space, a tiny desk studio and podcast studio, facilitating local space for music and theatre and lessons, as well as digital recording and podcasting. The windows are now replaced, and electrical work is complete, first podcast recording session was this week! We are grateful for these grants, and the opportunity to continue to make Laidlaw a useful and safe place for our church and community!
