

- <u>GRANT PROGRESS:</u> A Grant from the Ontario Anti-Hate Program of \$7,500.00 has facilitated installation of Cameras all around the church, and some additional funds beyond the cost of cameras will be used to replace the aging and now brittle plexiglass that protects the church's leaded glass windows. The Grant of \$28,000.00 from the Hamilton Presbytery Mission Council is helping to create the 'Artword Studio at Laidlaw'. Windows and electrical complete, repair of the ceiling is complete, painting has begun, with hopes of events in the space soon! Chairs have now been secured at a reasonable cost! Lots of progress!
