- 30% drop in loneliness
- 32% drop in anger issues
- 43% drop in bitterness or resentment
- 57% drop in struggles with alcoholism
- 60% drop in feelings of spiritual stagnation or feeling distant from God
- 65% drop in behavioral sins like sex outside of marriage or pornography viewing
- 200% to 228% increase in sharing one's faith with others
- 230% increase in commitment to discipling other believer

We must be committed to reading and studying God's Word. FCA Campus Huddles give our students the weekly discipline of reading and studying God's Word! In our weekly Huddles, students are equipped and empowered by God's Word!
