



Westbrook Homeowners Association Swimming Pool Rules and Information



1. The Association's swimming pools are private pools. Use them at your own risk. No lifeguard is on duty. Do not leave the pool gates open.
2. Owners may obtain pool keys from the Pool Committee for a one-time \$50.00 deposit, which is refundable. Swimmers' keys will be checked randomly to match with the key deposit list.
3. The larger pool is for family use; the smaller pool is for adults 18 years and older.
4. It is recommended that you do not swim alone.
5. Showering your child and yourself is recommended before using the pools.
6. Swimmers who are not toilet trained shall wear a swim diaper.
7. People with hair longer than shoulder-length must have it tied up, in braids or wear a swimming cap. No hair pins, bobby pins or hair accessories.
8. Food is not allowed in the pool areas. No drinks are permitted on the pool decks, except water in unbreakable plastic or metal containers. Glass containers are not allowed. Consumption of any beverages while in the pool is strictly prohibited.
9. No swimmers with bandages or open wounds. No cut-off shorts. No pets.
10. No diving, cannonballs, or jumping into pools. No running. No smoking.
11. No one in the pool over their head unless able to swim the length of the pool.
12. No air mattresses or flotation devices that are big enough to sit in/on in the pools at any time except for small flotation devices used for very young children learning to swim.
13. No more than six (6) guests per household at one time. Consult the pool committee chairperson for any special exception.
14. Adult residents shall accompany their guests of all ages to the pools plus accompany their own resident children 17 years and under, and they shall remain at the pools and be responsible for their children's and guests' behavior while at the pool. Resident children ages 18-21 can swim in either pool but they cannot bring guests or supervise younger children.
15. Any uncontrollable rowdiness or abusive behavior will be referred to the Beaverton Police.
16. Pool privileges may be suspended for up to thirty (30) days if residents or their guests violate the rules. The Board of Directors has authority to levy fines against rule offenders.
17. Owners delinquent on monthly assessments are not eligible to use the Westbrook pools.
18. Individuals at the pool entrances without a key are not allowed access.
19. Pool operating hours are posted on the gates at the beginning of each season.
20. Use of the clubhouse for a private event does not include use of the swimming pools.
