DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY SETS

The table below provides you with topics/stories and verses that can guide you as you read through the Bible this May and explore your new life in Christ. The passages do not need to be studied in any particular order, so feel free to select the studies that would work best for you and your group over this next month.

PURSUE LIFE: EXAMINE YOUR HEART

As you read through these studies, take a look inside your heart and better understand the “whys” driving your pursuits. Allow God to examine your heart so He can show you areas of your life that need to change.

PURSUE: EXAMINE YOUR HEART		
Jacob Before He Meets Esau	Genesis 32:9-32	Jacob has led a deceptive life. Between tricking his brother Esau out of his birthright or pulling a fast one on his father-in-law, Jacob's name literally means “deceiver.” Much has transpired for him through the years, and on the eve of reuniting with his brother, Jacob does some deep soul-searching. He wrestles with an angel of the LORD, who provokes him to honest and self-examination, before giving Jacob a new identity in the name Israel.
Moses and the Burning Bush	Exodus 3:1-20	Moses was brought up in the house of Pharaoh, but he couldn't escape his history as an Israelite. While in exile as a shepherd, God set the stage for a mighty exodus for his people, with Moses at the helm. But, Moses had 40 years to examine himself, the error of murdering a man, and his reasons for hiding out in the desert. When God invited Moses to join Him in freeing His people, Moses has matured, but still had to process who he was, his inadequacies, and who God was.
Saul's Conversion	Acts 9:1-19	Here we meet Saul on the way to imprison Jesus followers, where Jesus appears and calls him away from the life he led persecuting Christians. When God struck him blind and led him to the city of Damascus for three days, Saul, whose name changed to Paul, had plenty of time to ponder the majesty of Jesus and what his own heart motives were in denying Him. There was also time to consider what new life Jesus was leading him into.
David's Psalm of Testing	Psalms 26:1-7	In this Psalm, David asks the Lord to test him and examine his heart and mind. When we allow the Lord to examine our hearts, He will reveal where our motivations may be misaligned and will help us get back to the pursuit of those things He's called us to accomplish.
Walking in the Light	1 John 1:5-9	We are called to walk in the light as He is in the light. One of the first steps to be able to do this is to allow the Lord to examine your heart. This passage also reveals that we deceive ourselves if we claim to be without sin. The examination of our heart will reveal where we have sinned and will give us the opportunity to confess those sins to God.
Heart Examination	Jeremiah 17:7-10	This passage opens with a harsh reminder that our hearts can swiftly betray and lead us astray. But God offers refreshment in the next verse, reminding us that it is He who searches our hearts. When we open ourselves to honest examination and lay our hearts bare before God, He can help clean up the mess we make, restore what has been broken, and call us into greater relationship with Him and others.
Paul's Ministry in Thessalonica	1 Thessalonians 2:1-6	Sometimes we may find ourselves searching for the praise of men as a way to truly motivate us in our goal setting. In this passage, Paul addresses the fact that he was never looking for the praise of men. His goal, what truly motivated him, was to please God.
Examine Yourself First	Matthew 7:1-5	We are often times quick to judge other people rather than first taking a look at ourselves. Rather than judging others, allow the Lord to examine your heart and reveal areas in your life that need improvement.
