Baptism of the Lord

Today the church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. This feast brings an end to the Christmas season.

Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River by St. John the Baptist. On this day, Jesus entered into His public ministry.

Jesus was born free from sin. When he was baptized He purified the waters so that others could receive God's grace. At the time of Jesus' baptism, the heavens opened and God's voice declared, "You are my beloved Son whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

At Jesus' baptism, all the Persons of the Trinity were made known. The Father was known (through his voice from the heavens), the Son was made known (Jesus, who was baptized), and the Holy Spirit was made known (seen "descending like a dove.")

Jesus' baptism is a reminder of our own baptism where we became God's children. It is the beginning of our journey of faith, a gift which empowers us to live a life as children of God.

Dear God, Your voice moves over the waters. Immerse us in Your grace, mark us with Your images, and raise us to live our baptismal vows empowered by the Holy Spirit and the example of Christ our Lord, in whose name we pray. Amen
