A Jesse Tree represents the family tree of Jesus.

The tradition of the Jesse Tree dates back to the middle ages.

The Jesse Tree is named from Isaiah 11:1 "A shoot shall come out of the stock of Jesse and a branch shall grow out of his roots."

Jesse is the father of King David.

The ornaments of the Jesse tree tell the story of God in the Old Testament. These illustrated ornaments represent people, prophesies and the events leading up to the birth of Jesus.
