 - Father Hiep would really like our Parish to hold a bingo night, but we need someone to lead this, as well as several volunteers to assist

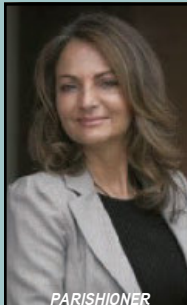

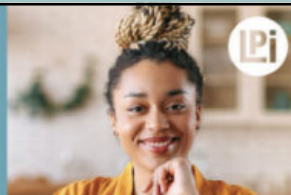
