We plan to bring back these popular "events":

1. Coffee & Conversations after 10:30AM Mass (coffee & light breakfast treats in the Peace Garden/ Rectory)
 - Frequency: Monthly during June, July, & August – dates TBD
 - Needs: 3 volunteers to rotate as a "lead" 1 of each of the 3 sessions, plus a team of 2-3 helpers
 - Time/resources needed: a few hours on one Sunday; some shopping, set up (tables/chairs, coffee maker), and clean up
2. Wine Tasting in the Peace Garden/Rectory (21 years old + event)
 - Frequency: one evening – date TBD
 - Needs: 5-6 volunteers to assist with logistics (getting wines/ food)
 - Time/resources needed: attend a few meetings (one hour each), some shopping/light cooking, set up and clean up
3. Adult Paint Night with Mermaid Masterpieces in the Church Hall
 - Frequency: one evening – date TBD
 - Needs: 2-3 volunteers to assist with set up/clean up
 - Time/resources: a few hours

We need your feedback/input on these "NEW" ideas:

1. **"Yard Sale" idea for parking lot or Church Hall**
 - Have people rent space (in lot or basement) and rent one of our tables, to sell their items (possibly invite people who make arts & crafts, etc.)
 - We would also have (donated) baked goods & coffee/water for sale
2. **"Musician Pub Night" in the Church Hall**
 - invite local musicians for a musical "jam session" (bring their own instruments, band mates)
 - we could possibly sell some food (maybe pizza, salad, water) or perhaps have some volunteers cook
 - we would sell tickets, perhaps by table (of 8 seats)
3. **Bingo Night in Church Hall**
 - Father Hiep would really like our Parish to hold a bingo night, but we need someone to lead this, as well as several volunteers to assist

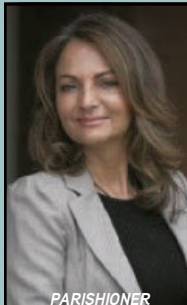

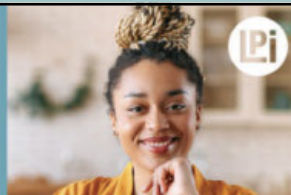
