- Frequency: one evening date TBD
- Needs: 2-3 volunteers to assist with set up/clean up
- Time/resources: a few hours

1. "Yard Sale" idea for parking lot or Church Hall

- Have people rent space (in lot or basement) and rent one of our tables, to sell their items (possibly invite people who make arts & crafts, etc.)
- We would also have (donated) baked goods & coffee/water for sale
- 2. "Musician Pub Night" in the Church Hall
- invite local musicians for a musical "jam session" (bring their own instruments, band mates)
- we could possibly sell some food (maybe pizza, salad, water) or perhaps have some volunteers cook
- we would sell tickets, perhaps by table (of 8 seats)
- 3. Bingo Night in Church Hall
- Father Hiep would really like our Parish to hold a bingo night, but we need someone to lead this, as well as several volunteers to assist
