Happy Fourth of July

Soon we will celebrate the most important day in American history. On this supremely significant day 240 years ago, fifty-six British land-owning men signed a watershed document, the Declaration of Independence, in a little-known Pennsylvnia colony. And this document would pave the future of what would arguably become the greatest nation in the world, the United States of America.

But John Adams set an example for us. After everything's said and done, we owe God more than anyone else for what occurred 240 years ago. In fact, the most famous part of the

Declaration of Independence explicitly points to God as the source of our freedom:
