

St.Vincent de Paul Reflection

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, after telling the parable of the good Samaritan, Jesus asks, "<u>which of these three, in your</u> <u>opinion, was neighbor to the robbers' victim?"</u> the scholar of the law answered, <u>"the one who treated him</u> <u>with mercy."</u> Jesus then answered, "<u>Go and do likewise</u>."

The scholar of the law asked "who is my neighbor?", but Jesus responds by asking who "was neighbor to the robbers' victim?" The question isn't "who is our neighbor?", but "who are we a neighbor to?" Then Jesus confirms the correct answer of the scholar, the one who treats the victim with mercy is the neighbor.

Baptized as **Catherine** ("Kateri" in Mohawk), and informally known as **Lily of the Mohawks** (1656 – April 17, 1680), is a <u>Mohawk/Algonquin Catholic saint</u> and <u>virgin</u>. Born in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon, in present-day New York, she contracted <u>smallpox</u> in an epidemic; her family died and her face was scarred. She converted to Catholicism at age 19. She took a vow of perpetual virginity, left her village, and moved for the remaining five years of her life to the <u>Jesuit</u> mission village of <u>Kahnawake</u>, just south of Montreal.

She was <u>beatified</u> in 1980 by <u>Pope John Paul II</u> and canonized by <u>Pope Benedict XVI</u> at <u>Saint Peter's Basiilica</u> on 21 October 2012.
