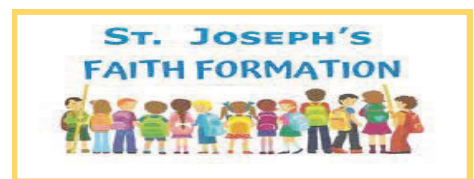
Healing can come in many forms from physical healing to spiritual or emotional healing and God knows what will help us the most.

Religious Education

"Be merciful as your Father is merciful." (Luke 6:36)

In a world full of concerns and pressure—jobs, the economy, immigration, poverty and need, war, violence, discord, divisions and polarization in our country, even divisions within the Church—what can we do? How can we accompany others in such difficult times?

Bishop Bruce Lewandowski says that amidst all of this "what's missing right now is mercy." Our bishop invites all people of good will to join him on MERCY21, a 21 day journey to reflect on, exercise, and pray for mercy beginning on Sunday, September 14, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, and ending with the Memorial of Saint Faustina on Sunday, October 5.

Each day, participants will be guided in: a Reflection on mercy, a practical way to Exercise mercy, and a Prayer for mercy. Together, these daily REPs (Reflection, Exercise, Prayer) will draw from the 7-Spiritual Works of Mercy, the 7-Corporal Works of Mercy, and the 7-Principles of Catholic Social Teaching.

Bishop Bruce extends his personal invitation: "I ask you to join me for 21 days of mercy. We will reflect on, exercise, and pray for mercy—asking the Lord's mercy for ourselves, and sharing His mercy with others."

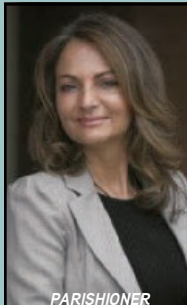

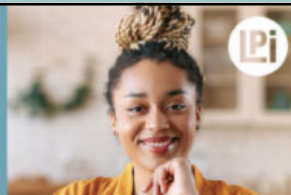
