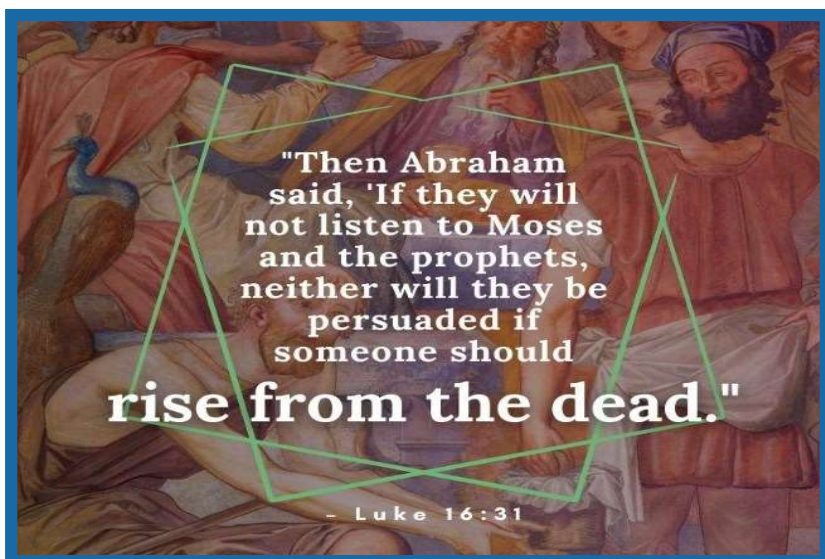

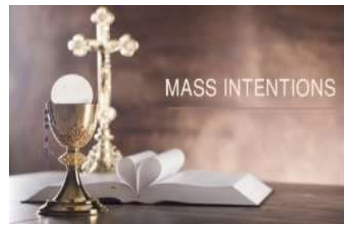

Please take a bag and return it with one or more of the items on the enclosed list, or any food items, the following weekend or any weekend in September and October. We are very grateful for

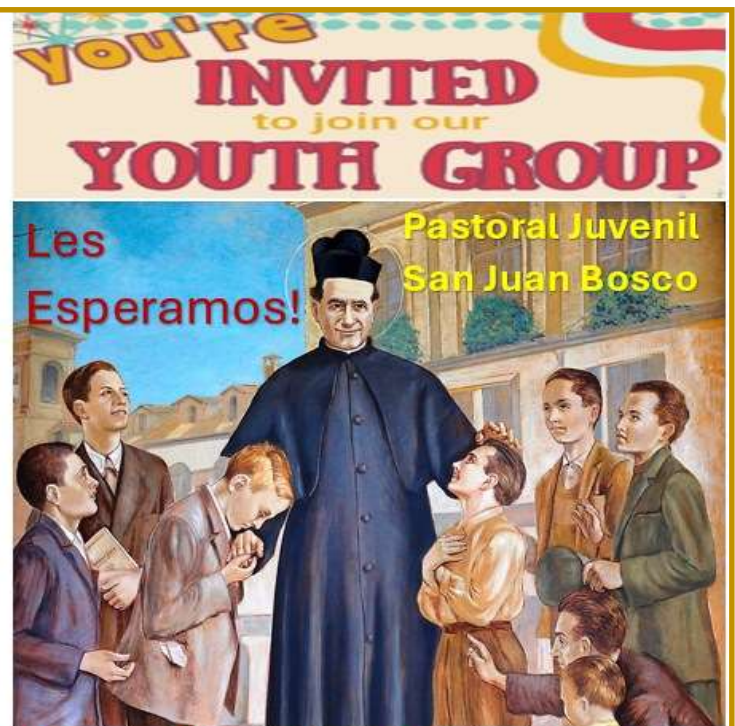

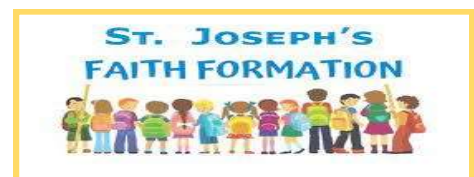

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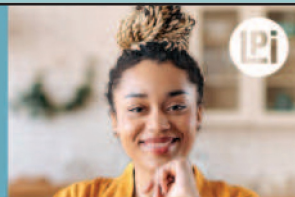
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
