

Farmington Memorial Park

Cemetery Maintenance Standards

Updated: March 2026

Adopted February 1, 2021 in accordance with the Cemetery & Funeral Bureau Section 2333 of Division 23 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (a) and (c).

Farmington Memorial Park's Rules & Regulations are hereby supplemented with Maintenance Standards in accordance with Health & Safety Code 8300 as follows:

Maintenance: 1) Mow lawns 32 times each year:

1-January, 1-February, 4-March, 6-April, 4-May, 4-June, 4-July, 4-August, 2-September, 1-October, 1-November, 0-December.

- 2) Irrigation System – repair mainlines.
- 3) Garbage Pickup 24 times each year – two times each month at approximately the beginning and middle of the month.
- 4) Weed-eating 13 times each year according to the following schedule: 1-January, 0-February, 1-March, 2-April, 2-May, 2-June, 2-July, 1-August, 1-September, 0-October, 1-November, 0-December.
- 5) Spray weeds two times each year on the roads, paths, and parking area according to the following schedule: 1-March, 1-July.
- 6) Service equipment three times each year according to the following schedule: 1-March, 1-July, 1-October
- 7) Headstone maintenance is the responsibility of the family. For those participating in the quarterly maintenance program offered by Farmington Memorial Park, the four times per year schedule: March 31st, May 25th, August 1st, November 30th.
- 8) Prune shrubs and trees in and around the cemetery annually in the late Fall.
- 9) Rodent control program is ongoing to keep damage to a minimum. Local conditions next to orchards prohibit a complete or permanent eradication. Squirrels are controlled by carbon monoxide and bait traps. Gophers and moles are trapped, bait is also used.
- 10) Fill in sunken graves from winter rains. Ongoing, initial completion by September 1. Fill newly sunken graves (usually from vault failures) within 45 days when weather permits.
- 11) Seek support from Masonic Lodge to repair their monument during 2026.
