2	Exhibitors may submit only one entry per class.
3	Fruit, flowers, vegetables and pot plants must have been grown by the exhibitor.
4	Cut flowers should be shown with own foliage. Dishes, containers or vases to be provided by exhibitor. A vase to have a greater height than mouth measurement.
5	Baked products must be covered in cling film.
6	All entries to be staged between 10:00 and 11.30 am on Show Day.
7	After staging, please leave the hall.
8	All exhibits are shown at exhibitor's risk.
9	The decision of the judges is final.
10	Presentation of trophies will take place at 3:30pm.
11	Points awarded are: 1st - 3pts, 2nd - 2pts, 3rd -1pt except for Classes 13, 25 and 32 when points are doubled.
12	Please ensure your entry form is submitted by 6.00 pm on Thursday 10 th September 2026 either by hand or on-line – details on the Entry Form.

Vegetables and Fruit

Class	
1	5 White potatoes 1 variety.
2	3 carrots, tops trimmed to 3 inches.
3	3 dressed and ripened onions. 1 variety. Tops trimmed and tied with Raffia.
4	Plate of 10 shallots. 1 variety. To be displayed on a plate of dry sand.
5	3 beetroot, tops trimmed. 1 named variety.
6	5 tomatoes. 1 variety. (calyx intact).
7	6 cherry tomatoes, 1 variety. (calyx intact) not to exceed 35 mm diameter.
8	6 Climbing beans. 1 variety.
9	Longest runner bean.
10	2 courgettes. 1 variety. Approximately 150mm long and 35mm diameter.
11	Any other vegetable. (Points awarded according to cultivation difficulty)
12	Tray (not to exceed 18" x 12") of 4 kinds of vegetables - 3 of each. Parsley can be used to dress.
13	5 kinds of fresh culinary/floral herbs. (Herbs to be named & to be displayed in water). Double Points Class.
14	3 culinary apples with stalks attached.
15	3 dessert apples with stalks attached.
16	Plate of 7 plums. 1 variety with stalks attached. Do not wash.
17	Plate of any other fruit. 1 variety, maximum 12 fruits (Points awarded according to cultivation difficulty).

Flowers and Pot Plants

18	Vase of 3 penstemons, 1 or more varieties.
19	Vase of 3 stems of dahlias, any varieties.
20	Vase of 3 stems, roses. 1 or more varieties.
21	1 specimen rose. – Foliage optional.
22	Vase of 3 stems of chrysanthemums, any variety.
23	Vase of 6 stems, annual flowers.1 variety.
24	Vase of 6 stems, herbaceous perennial flowers.1 variety. <i>Vase neck not to exceed 10 cm (4") diameter.</i>
25	Vase of 6 stems, mixed garden flowers. At least 3 varieties. <i>Vase neck not to exceed 10 cm (4") diameter. Double Points Class.</i>
26	Vase of 6 stems of shrubs. 1 or more varieties.
27	1 hydrangea bloom.
28	1 foliage pot plant. Home grown. Pot diameter not to exceed 15cm (6").
29	1 flowering pot plant Home grown Pot diameter not to exceed 15cm (6").

30	1 cactus or succulent in a pot or pan. <i>Pot diameter not to exceed 15cm (6")</i>
31	A Succulent arrangement in a pot . <i>Pot diameter not to exceed 30cm (12"). Special Award Class.</i>

Decorative

32	Arrangement of any flowers in a wine glass. Double Points Class.
33	An arrangement of garden grown English wild flowers in a vase.
34	Autumnal Hedgerow Display.
35	A sensory and tactile hand held posy for a blind person.
36	A floating floral display in water not exceeding 20cm (8") diameter.

Home Produce

37	Jar of fruit jam (300gm - 500gm jar).
38	Jar of marmalade (300gm - 500gm jar).
39	Jar of fruit Jelly (300gm – 500gm jar).
40	Jar of chutney (300gm - 500gm jar).
41	Plate of 6 savoury scones.
42	Victoria Sandwich Cake {3 eggs, raspberry jam, (no sugar on top)}.
43	Tray Bake, plate of 6 portions.
44	A savoury flan Size 8 to 9 ins. diameter – removed from tin.
45	Loaf of Homemade Bread – any type.
