Season 20 Half Year Season Kicks off on Monday, December 1st!!

- Teams were determined by age, tumbling ability level and stunting position
- Half Year is a Prep Division in All Star Cheerleading
- All teams are listed with tumble levels only. The stunting level will be determined once teams are able to work together by choreography.
- Due to the number of teams and limited levels within the Prep Division, some CFAS teams may compete against each other. Teams in the same locations will not compete against each other.
- Team Practices begin the week of Monday, December 1st!!
- All teams will practice once per week for 2 hours.
- All athletes must be registered for the season. Please make sure your athlete is registered for the 2025-2026 Half Year season. Registration fee has increased to \$150 after evaluations.
- All planned absences for the season must be reported to HEAD coaches by December 5th via email. We understand there may be an instance an athlete is sick, please email coaches right away.
- Team Facebook pages will be created and families will start to be added. Team page links will be shared with all families. All Star season information can be found on the website, please review all documents.
- Please log into your Iclass Parent Portal account to ensure all demographic information including athlete date of birth is accurate. Double check that your account is set to subscribe or you will not receive any emails from CheerFactor.
- Please ensure you have a credit card on file on your portal account that is set up for recurring payments for auto draft. This is our policy for all families.
- December tuition will be added to all accounts and charged on December 1st
- Uniform fee & Bow will be added to all accounts and charged on December 15th.
- Cheer Fees will be auto draft on the 1st of the month for the season (January – March) in addition to tuition.
- Please see pricing guide, financial obligation and refund policy for additional information. These can be found on the website.
- Winter Class Schedule is available on Monday, December 1st. All Half Year athletes will receive 50% off TUMBLE classes (excluding Open Gym). When registering for your class, please use code 25AS at checkout.

Pricing Guide

Registration Fee : paid each season by all athletes \$125
On time or \$150 after season begins

Tuition: The yearly cost of being rostered on a CFAS team, divided by **12** months (June-May) with the exception of Tiny and Mini teams which is divided by 11 months (June-April) AND Half Year teams which is divided by 5 months (December – April). Hours of practice time will vary without adjustments to tuition payments. Tuition will be automatically charged on the 1st of the month with the exception of June 2025 tuition which will be charged on May 26, 2025.

Tuition Includes:

The yearly cost of being rostered on a CFAS team for all teams.

Cheer Fees : Please see the below for what is and is not included in the Cheer Fees. Cheer Fees are added together and split among 7 months for Full Year teams and 3 months for Novice and Half Year teams.

Cheer Fees:

- Competition Fees for all competitions
- Routine Choreography
- All Star Stunt Clinic (Full Year Only)
- Music
- Coaches Fees (with the exception of post season)

Cheer Fees do not include:

- USASF Yearly Registration fee – paid to USASF (mandatory for all athletes to compete)
- Uniform
- Practice Wear (Full Year Only)
- Sneakers – Competition sneakers are Mandatory for Full Year, ordered through CFAS – Navy Varsity Sneakers. Athletes must have white cheer sneakers for practice. XFACTOR will have white Competition cheer Sneakers.
- Competition Bow
- Make up
- Optional Pro Shop

Uniform:

Those crossing from **Worlds to Elite** will have a second uniform as well as mandatory navy competition sneakers to purchase.

Crossover from **Junior to Youth** will need to purchase the skirt for the crossover uniform.

Practice Wear : Practice wear is mandatory for all **full year** teams.

Practice Wear will be the CFAS Ralieggh Rhinestones bra & Varsity shorts (worn for 2025 Post Season).

Additional team specific practice wear will be ordered in the Fall. Fee for practice wear.

****Post Season practice wear will be separate from the above.**

Cross Over Fee : Cost for being on a second team Cross Over tuition is \$30 per team per month. Additional crossover fee will be due for competition fees for the second team. This fee will be totaled and split over 2 months.

Post Season Expenses (Full Year Only): cost for attending post season competitions is completely separate from regular season costs. Expenses will be determined closer to post season events. This season there will be a coach's fee charged for each post season event you will be competing with. Any additional expenses will be shared as soon as they become available. Pricing estimates are based on 2024/2025 pricing.

Post Season Expenses (Half Year Only): cost for attending post season competitions is completely separate from regular season costs.

Financial Obligation

All parents/guardians must understand that they assume full responsibility for all costs incurred as a member of CheerFactor All Stars including, but not limited to, gym registration & evaluation fees, monthly tuition, practice wear, uniforms, competition and travel expenses, camp & choreography fees, or any other items(s), reservations or services purchased or rendered to CheerFactor All Stars and that payment in full is due for those items, regardless of any circumstances that may arise.

- All customers MUST have a credit card/debit card on file for monthly auto draft purposes for all cheer expenses
- All monthly payments are due on the 1st of the month unless otherwise specified
- Your tuition will be automatically charged on the 1st of each month, unless otherwise specified. If this charge is declined or you do not have a credit card on file to be charged, you will be charged a \$25 declined transaction fee.
- Any tuition not paid by the 10th of the month will be charged to the card for a second attempt. If the charge is declined a second time you will be charged an additional \$25 declined transaction fee along with a \$25 late fee.
- Your Cheer Fee and/or Crossover Fee will be automatically charged on the 1st of each month due. If this charge is declined or you do not have a credit card on file to be charged, you will be charged a \$25 declined transaction fee.
- Any fee not paid by the 10th of the month will be charged to the card for a second attempt. If the charge is declined a second time you will be charged an additional \$25 declined transaction fee along with a \$25 late fee.
- Any payments resulting in non sufficient funds, declined credit card, expired credit card, returned check and electronic debits, etc. will incur a \$25 declined transaction fee. It is your responsibility to ensure the card on file is in good standing, fees will not be waived for account oversights.
- Late fees of \$25 will be assessed on any and all past due fees at increments of 10 days, 30 days, 60 days, 90 days
- Tuition pays for training. It does not pay for the right to perform.
- Vacation or time off is not prorated. Hours of practice time will vary without tuition charges being adjusted.
- All accounts must be in good standing to continue to participate in practices, competitions, and other events.
- Accounts over 30 days past due are subject to athlete suspension until account is brought current. Parents will be notified of past due account via email, once your child is at risk of suspension you will be notified a second time via email. If there is no response to these messages after these two communications, the athlete will be sat until further notice.
- Any athlete with a past due balance over 30 days will not be able to participate in private lessons, camps or clinics
- All tuition and fees must be current before an athlete may collect any practice wear, uniform, sneakers or any other retail items.
- Current payments cannot be made when there are past due expenses, past due expenses will be paid first.
- Any monies received from Boosters will not be applied toward tuition and are only applied toward tangible items based on Booster guidelines
- Please refer to the Refund policy for all questions on refunds and withdrawal fees
- Attending competitions is mandatory. You will be charged a fee of \$500 when notifying us of inability to compete up until the Wednesday prior to the competition. Should you notify us after Wednesday or no show at a competition you will be charged \$1500 for not attending a competition. Missing a Red Zone practice resulting in missing a competition, there will be a missed competition fee of \$500. Missing a post season competition will result in a missed competition fee of \$500.
- **We have implemented a missed competition policy for Half Year. Any athlete who misses a competition this season will be charged a fee of \$500. It is imperative to the team to have full attendance at a competition in order to perform their routine. EXCEPTION to this policy is if it is disclosed at evaluations that a competition will be missed. At evaluations, all families will sign the competition schedule and make note if they cannot attend a specific event. IF it is noted on your form that you will miss a competition, the fee will be waived. This will be the only exception.**
- Withdrawal fees will apply to all athletes, withdrawal after choreography or August 1st (whichever comes first) will result in a withdrawal fee of \$300. A withdrawal after October 1st will result in a withdrawal fee of \$500. This will include dropping a crossover team for Full Year.
- Half Year Withdrawal fees will apply to all athletes, withdrawal after choreography will result in a withdrawal fee of \$300.
- CheerFactor All Stars reserves the right to turn over all delinquent accounts to collection agencies and the parent/guardian will be responsible for all additional costs incurred.
- CheerFactor All Stars reserves the right to remove an athlete from their team at any time for failure to keep up with financial obligations.



Red Zone Practices

The expectation is that athletes attend all scheduled practices. For information regarding the attendance policy please refer to the Parent Guidebook. The EXCEPTION to regularly scheduled practices will be Red Zone practices. During these practice attendance is MANDATORY with NO EXCEPTIONS. Not attending these practices will result in being removed from the team roster for that week's competition.

Red Zone – The week/week(s) leading up to ALL scheduled competitions, this will be all practices from Saturday-Friday prior to competition weekend. Below is the breakdown of each scheduled Red Zone for each competition.
