

# Half Year Prep

We are excited to get started with our Half Year Program for the 2025-2026 Season! Below are some frequently asked questions that might be helpful as you prepare to register your athlete for an exciting season of All Star Cheerleading!

# What is the age requirement for Half Year?

Athletes born between 6/1/2006 - 2019 are eligible for Half Year this season.

# When do teams practice and for how long?

Half Year Teams will practice once per week for two hours each practice.

**Practices begin the week of December.** Practices schedules for the season will vary depending on team placement. Practice schedule will be released at team reveal.

# Does my athlete need to be evaluated?

Yes. All athletes must be evaluated to be placed on a team.

Early Bird Evaluations in Norton & Hanover – October 17th

On time Evaluations in Norton, Hanover & Rhode Island – November 15th

# What is the registration fee?

Registration fee is the cost of being rostered on an All-Star team for the season. This is a one-time fee at the start of each season.

Early Bird registration begins September 1st for \$100

On Time registration begins October 1st for \$125

# How long is the season?

The season begins December 1st and ends April 17th (post season event on April 18th).

# How do I know what team my athlete has been placed on?

We will do a virtual team reveal on November 22<sup>nd</sup>. You will receive an email with your team placement. All season information will be placed on our website for review.

### What is monthly tuition?

Monthly tuition for Half Year teams this season is \$135 per month. Tuition is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month for the months of December – April.

# Is registration different than tuition?

Yes, they are two different fees.

### Do Half Year teams participate in competitions?

Yes! All our Half Year teams will compete. They perform on stage in full uniform with a choreographed routine! This season Half Year teams will participate in 3 local competitions and a post season competition. Competition dates and locations are as follows:

- February 28<sup>th</sup> Providence, RI
- March 8<sup>th</sup> Lowell, MA
- March 28<sup>th</sup> Uncasville, CT
- Post Season April 18<sup>th</sup> Worcester, MA

# Do Half Year teams compete against other teams?

Yes. Teams are judged, scored and receive recognition based on the strength of their performance. They are recognized, ranked and awarded placements.

# Do Half Year teams have choreography?

Yes. Half Year choreography dates are December 20<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>. Team specific date/time will be available at reveal.

#### What is a Cheer Fee?

Our Cheer Fee is the combination of all competition fees (with the exception of post season), music fees, choreography fees and coaches' fees. These fees are added up and split over 3 payments. These payments are in addition to tuition and will be due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month for the months of January, February and March. This season's cheer fee is \$300 per installment.

# Are there additional mandatory fees?

Yes!

Uniform - \$275

Competition bow - \$30

USASF Membership Fee (paid directly to USASF before competing) - \$49

Post Season Competition fee - \$125 (bids are available which would lessen their fee)

### Does my athlete need cheer sneakers?

Yes, they will need white cheer shoes. You can order through the gym to get a Varsity brand sneakers. You can also order on your own, it is not mandatory to order sneakers through the gym, but athletes must have white cheer shoes.

### Is there additional information available with additional policies?

Yes! All our information for this All-Star season can be found on our website under All Star. Please take a few minutes to review all the information listed. Please keep in mind, our Full Year Elite program began in June so lots of schedules, etc. will be geared toward them, but all policies and guidebook are program wide.

# Is there an attendance policy?

Yes. Attendance for half year is super important. The season is short and teams only practice once per week. The expectation is that athletes are at practices. Athletes will be allowed 3 absences for the season. Please note Red Zone practices are mandatory. Red Zone practices begin the Sunday prior to the competition weekend. Any Extended Red Zones will be available at the reveal.
