



Tiny Novice

We are excited to get started with our Tiny Novice athletes for the 2025-2026 Season!

Below are some frequently asked questions that might be helpful as you prepare to register your little one for an exciting season of All Star Cheerleading!

What is the age requirement for Tiny Novice?

Athletes born between 2018-2022 are eligible for Tiny Novice this season.

When do teams practice and for how long?

Tiny Novice practices are 45 minutes - one hour in length. Parents do not go into the gym for practices; athletes will be lead through practice with their coach.

Practices begin the week of September 8th. Practices schedules for the season are as follows (depending on location)

- Hanover - Monday 6:30-7:30pm
- Norton - Friday 6:30-7:30pm
- Rhode Island - Wednesday 5:45-6:30pm

Does my Tiny need to be evaluated?

Evaluations will be held for those attending the RI location only. These evaluations will be held on August 24th at 11am. All interested athletes should plan to attend.

What is the registration fee?

Registration fee is the cost of being rostered on an All-Star team for the season. This is a one-time fee at the start of each season.

How long is the season?

The season begins September 1st and ends April 17th (post season event on April 18th).

What is monthly tuition?

Monthly tuition for Novice teams this season is \$100 per month. Tuition is due on the 1st of the month for the months of September – April.

Is registration different than tuition?

Yes, they are two different fees.

Do Novice teams participate in competitions?

Yes! All our Novice teams attend competitions. They perform on stage in full uniform with a choreographed routine! This season Tiny Novice will participate in 3 local competitions and a post season competition.

Competition dates and locations are as follows:

- February 28th – Providence, RI
- March 8th – Lowell, MA
- March 28th – Uncasville, CT
- Post Season – April 18th – Worcester, MA



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Do Novice teams compete against other teams?

No. However, teams are judged, scored and receive recognition based on the strength of their performance. They are recognized and awarded, but not ranked 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. against other Tiny Novice teams.

What is a Cheer Fee?

Our Cheer Fee is the combination of all competition fees (with the exception of post season), music fees, choreography fees and coaches' fees. These fees are added up and split over 3 payments. These payments are in addition to tuition and will be due on the 1st of the month for the months of November, December and January. This season's cheer fee is \$275 per installment.

Are there additional mandatory fees?

Yes!

Uniform - \$275

Competition bow - \$30

USASF Membership Fee (paid directly to USASF before competing) - \$49

Post Season Competition fee - \$125 (bids are available which would lessen their fee)

Does my Tiny need cheer sneakers?

Yes, they will need white cheer shoes. You can order through the gym to get a Varsity brand sneakers. You can also order on your own, it is not mandatory to order sneakers through the gym, but athletes must have white cheer shoes.

Is there additional information available with additional policies?

Yes! All our information for this All-Star season can be found on our website under All Star. Please take a few minutes to review all the information listed. Please keep in mind, our Full Year Elite program began in June so lots of schedules, etc. will be geared toward them, but all policies and guidebook are program wide.
