NO SCHOOL & E-LEARNING DAYS

On most scheduled no school and e-learning days, the Teen Center is open for Club members from 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM. There is no additional cost to attend these days.

GETTING TO & FROM THE CLUB

FREE MEALS & SNACK!

Our meal program serves Club members a free, healthy dinner and snack each day after school. On no school days, the Teen Center serves breakfast, lunch and snack. See monthly menus on our website.

Stick around and stay late! Our Teen Center is open until 10:00 PM every Friday after school. Late Nights come with a free extra dinner, plus fun themed nights all school year long, including one night each month that's planned entirely by teens, for teens, by Keystone (our Club member leadership council). No extra cost or registration is necessary.

COMING SOON...

Expanding Opportunities for Youth & Teens

We are proud to share that our community has already invested \$4 million toward our \$6 million capital campaign. This will help us create a dedicated Teen Center, expand our kitchen and cafeteria, and increase program space. With a \$1 million matching gift opportunity available, now is the moment to help us reach the finish line.

This expansion will:

- More than double the number of teens we serve each year—from 250 to more than 500
- Increase the Schierl Center's daily capacity from 170 to 340 youth and teens
- Create dedicated spaces for mentoring, academic support, leadership development, workforce readiness, counseling, cooking classes, and life-skills programming
