HELD UNDER THE SANCTION OF USA SWIMMING

SANCTION #: WI-26-2008

Held under the sanction of USA Swimming. Current USA Swimming and WSI rules, including safety and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”) will govern this meet and be strictly enforced. **In granting this sanction/approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming Inc shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.** The [Wisconsin Meet Reservation Form](#) will be used to secure entry into the meet.

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. This includes participation as a member of a relay. These athletes will also be considered “not in good standing” and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1. *Underwater photography of any kind is prohibited at all times during this meet in any pool.*

The USA Swimming Safe Sport program is USA Swimming’s comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations.

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Adult Participants (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes that are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Adult Participants are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member’s responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or when specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

For information on how to report other alleged violations, including, without limitation, the USA Swimming Code of Conduct and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, please visit www.usaswimming.org/report.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after 10/April, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or



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after 10/April, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Only contestants, coaches, volunteer meet support, timers and working meet officials will be granted access to the competitive area. Current USA Swimming membership card must be continuously displayed while on deck.

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. *Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.*

Certified lifeguards will be present throughout the meet. A first aid kit and an AED will be available on deck.

Awards will be given for 1st – 10th place in individual events for 8 & under, 9/10, and 11/12 age categories. Meet results will be posted online at www.swimfsc.org

On-deck registrations will not be processed. Age as of the first day of competition shall determine age for the meet.

FACILITY	The competition pool is an 8, 9, or 10-lane 50-meter course ranging from 7' 0" to 7' 1" in depth. Lanes are 7' 4" wide with 6-inch Kiefer Wave Eater Lane Lines and Kiefer Elite Starting Platforms. Colorado timing system and display. The meet host will ensure the required course dimensions. Spectator seating will open 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each session. A fully automatic Colorado timing system with button and watch backups for each lane will be used.

ENTRY FEES	The individual event entry fee is \$7.00 per individual event. A Wisconsin Swimming surcharge of \$4.00, \$10.00 admissions surcharge, and a RecPlex facility surcharge of \$7.00 per swimmer entered in individual events must be included with entry. Make checks payable to "Lake Forest Swim Club" . Deck entries may be accepted if open lanes are available; the entry fee is \$10.00.

EVENTS, ENTRY LIMITATIONS, PARA ACCOMMODATION and SEEDING	An event schedule for this meet is included with this meet announcement. Swimmers may enter and swim six (6) individual events each day. The Sr 400 and 800 free will be swum in alternating fashion, fastest to slowest seeded heats. All events except heat-limited events will be conducted as pre-seeded timed final events. Swimmers competing in heat-limited events are required to check in and positively declare their intent to swim for each event. Swimmers who do not check in will be scratched from that event. Positive check-in will close 30 minutes after the start of warmup of the session the event is contested. Special seeding procedures will be used for disability athletes (see USA Rule 202.2.13). Use of the WSI Para Accommodation Form is encouraged for all accommodation and/or modification requests that must be presented to a meet referee (per USAS Rule 105.1.2) The following events <i>MAY</i> be limited to three heats based on submitted entry times: 9/10 200 free and 200 IM, 11/12 400 free and 200 IM, Sr 400 and 800 free, and all 200 stroke events. All swimmers entered in heat-limited events must provide a seed time. To check seeding for heat-limited events visit www.swimlfc.org after <i>April 27, 2026</i> , for more information.		



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Swimmers may enter and swim six (6) individual events plus relays each day. The Sr 400 and 800 free will be swum in alternating fashion, fastest to slowest seeded heats. Please submit LCM entry times. The following events *MAY* be limited to three heats based on submitted entry times:

- 10&under 100m events
- Sr 400 free, 800 free and all 200m events
- 12 & under 200 IM and 400 Free
