

2026 STAR Spring Splash Swim Meet Overview
Held Under Sanction of USA Swimming
WI Sanction # WI-26-2014

- Date: Saturday May 30, 2026
- Overview: The STAR Summer Splash Meet will take place in two Saturday sessions held under the sanction of USA Swimming. All events will be timed finals. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Location: Stoughton High School Pool | 600 Lincoln Ave. | Stoughton, WI 53589
Pool Entrance is on the west side of the high school and is accessible from Devonshire Road. It is recommended to Google Stoughton High School Pool for directions.
- Facility: Indoor, eight (8) Lane, 25 yard pool. The minimum water depth is 12 feet at the start end and 3 feet, 6 inches at the turn end. All 25 yard events will start from the start end and end at the turn end. For the 100 yard relays, the 2nd and 4th legs of the relay will have to start in the water. Timing for the 25 yard events will be via two (2) back-up push buttons and two (2) stopwatches at the turn end of the pool. The pool is also equipped with non-turbulent lane markers, backstroke flags and slanted, 30" high starting blocks. Upper deck spectator seating is available. The Meet host will ensure the required course dimensions. Concession stand with adjacent tables and chairs for spectator, swimmer, coach, and official breaks.
- Lifeguards will be available at all times during the running of the meet, including warm-ups.
- Medical Supervision: Report injuries to the Lifeguard staff and Meet Director. The Lifeguard staff will assist with first aid.
- Timing System: All events will be timed using a Colorado Timing System with horn start, touch pads (start end), one (1) button plunge timer, and two (2) stopwatches as back-ups, except as noted above for 25 yard events.
- Official Rules: This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and WSI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced. All participants must be registered athlete members of USA Swimming and be in good standing. Swimmer's age is as of May 30, 2026.
- Racing Start Certification: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

- Meet Schedule: Session 1 for Saturday, May 30, 2026
- Warm Up: 8:00-9:00AM
 - Session Starts: 9:05AM
 - Fly-Over Starts Where Applicable
 - Breaks will be added if necessary
- Session 2 for Saturday, May 30, 2026
- Warm Up: Will begin 10 minutes after the completion of Session 1.
 - Session Starts: 5 minutes after the completion of the warm-up period.
 - Fly-Over Starts Where Applicable
 - Breaks will be added if necessary
- Warm-Ups: Warm-up assignments will be sent to the team representatives ahead of the meet. Warm-up procedures are at the discretion of the teams warming up in each specific lane; no equipment (snorkels, kickboards, or other training devices) may be used. Warm-up time frames subject to change depending on size of meet. Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to warm-ups for lane assignment.
- Entries: Swimmers may compete in a total of five (5) events. This may be up to five (5) individual events or up to four (4) individual events plus one (1) relay. Swimmers must be USA Swimming registered in order to enter. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis until the meet is full. Entries not accepted will be notified as soon as possible. This meet will be run using Hy-Tek Meet Manager.
- Entry Deadline: The entry chair must receive Hy-Tek file of your entries no later than **Tuesday, May 19, 2026 @ 10:00PM**. No entries will be taken over the phone. **Email meet entries to STARmeetdirector@gmail.com**. Received entries will be confirmed via email. Meet entry fees and signed waiver form can be brought to the meet director the day of the meet.
- Entry Fees: \$4.00 LSC Splash Fee, \$5.00 per individual event, \$16.00 per relay, and \$4.00 facility fee. A \$10.00 per swimmer admission fee will be assessed with swimmer registration.
- Deck Entries: Deck entries will be at the Meet Director's discretion, will only be allowed up until 30 minutes prior to the start of the session AND only if there are open lanes available (new heats will not be added). Deck entries must be able to prove their current USA Swimming membership. No on-site USA Swimming registrations will be accepted. Deck entry is \$10 per individual event (plus entry fees if the athlete is not already registered in the meet).
- Deck Registration: No USAS registrations will be completed.
- Para Athletes: Use of the WSI Para Accommodation Form is required for all accommodations and/or modification requests. Please make sure a copy of this form has been submitted to the Meet Referee prior to the start of the meet.
- Awards: Ribbons will be given for individual events 10 & Under and open. 10 & Under events will be awarded as follows: 8 & Under and 9 – 10. Open events will be awarded as follows: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13 & Over. Relay events ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place. Awards will be held for each team and can be picked up by a team representative at the end of the session/meet. Awards will NOT be mailed, should a team not pick up their awards, we will make an effort to bring them to a future swim meet to get them to you.
- Meet Conduct: All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Director and Meet Marshals have the authority to

remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athletes/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

MAAPP: Pursuant to WI Swimming, Inc. mandate, all adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered “not in good standing” and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

SAFE SPORT 360:

The USA Swimming Safe Sport program is USA Swimming’s comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations.

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Adult Participants (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Adult Participants are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member’s responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

For information on how to report other alleged violations, including without limitation, the USA Swimming Code of Conduct and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, please visit www.usaswimming.org/report.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after April 30, 2026, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after April 30, 2026, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without

completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

Image Authorization:

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

Admissions:

The admission fee is being assessed with the swimmer fees, spectators will be welcomed upon arrival and directed to the viewing area. Heat sheets will be electronically sent to teams the day prior to the swim meet for download. A paper copy of the heat sheet will be posted in the hallway outside the pool and on deck the morning of the swim meet. A limited quantity of printed heat sheets may be available at concessions. The meet will be accessible via meet mobile.

Concession:

Food and beverages will be available for purchase throughout the meet. Food and beverages (other than bottled water) will not be allowed on the pool deck.

Meet Results:

One electronic copy of meet results will be sent to all participating teams and WI Swimming.
