Installation & Care

- Cut using standard snap off blade knife
- Installation as per 'Best Practice Guidelines Carpet Floorcoverings Planning & Installation 5.3'. Use 48mm paper tape on all joins. On concrete floors recommendation is to spray contact adhesive around perimeter of sub floor and under all joins to secure for handling of carpet.
- Dispose of packaging responsibly.
