## A glimpse of the God Who Sees

### Yet another testimony to the effect of spreading kindness....

"I have had the opportunity to have what I call Divine appointments that the Lord sets up. I thought you would be encouraged hearing about one involving the blessing/outreach baggies that were given out at church.

[My husband] and I together had 6 to give out. Two of them we left at the table of restaurants, blessing our servers. One I gave to a young man at a gas station, another to a Turkey Hill cashier. [My husband] gave out another. It was weeks later and the last baggie was still in my car as I waited for the Lord to provide a divine appointment. I was praying about it, but I didn't sense direction. The Monday after Thanksgiving, I was traveling east through the wooded section on 322, and I noticed a car with 4-way blinkers flashing, pulled to the side of the road. As I passed, I felt the Lord say, "turn around". I was hesitant and questioning but decided to turn around to see if they needed help. A man and woman were standing near a tree, and as I walked towards them, I asked if they needed help. They responded "no" and as I got closer, I saw a cross and flowers. It occurred to me that they were remembering a loved one's passing. Two family members died here in a head on collision two years ago. I saw the pain on their faces. Before the thought had even formed, the Spirit prompted me to say, "May I pray for you?" I'm pretty sure that I've never before asked strangers this question! They said yes, and I prayed a prayer of peace and comfort for their grieving hearts. After the prayer, I retrieved the baggie from my car and handed it to them. I told them it seemed so small a token but that it was from my heart at the prompting of the Lord. We had a light moment when they joked that they would share the items in the baggie.

When God provides these divine appointments, they are faith builders for me and such an encouragement to me, especially when I'm feeling that God isn't hearing me or that He is silent. We are to wait on His timing for these appointments and then obey when He provides them. My faith is weak, but He is strong."
