Minutes

Financials

Joe Bean presented the financial report for March. Financial performance for the month was strong despite revenue -30k to the budget as COGS were -13k and expenses were -29k, so income was +13k for the month. Payroll, capital improvements and marketing were a combined -31k to budget for the month.

A motion was made and duly seconded to accept the financials as presented. This was voted on and approved.

Greens report

The final stages of the irrigation project remaining are the mains on 2,3,5, and 6, which should take 2 more weeks. The sanding, painting and refilling of the 2 water tanks should be done by mid May. The tank on 8 is nearly complete and will be opened next week. The project on the left side of 3 will be completed by mid May as well. All 18 holes will be open for the opening scramble. The superintendent position applicants have been narrowed down to 10 people that we interviewed and have further narrowed the list of candidates to 4. These 4 will have tours of the course and be interviewed again in person over the coming months. The intent is to hire in the fall to work in transition with Neil through the end of the season.

Pro Shop report

All merch will be in by mid may. Early selling has been strong.

Social committee

Carlin is going to meet with John (F&B manager) and Courtney in the coming month to set up a social meeting and begin creating a list of events for the season.

House report

All lights downstairs are being changed to LED.
