Your holiday itinerary (ex Perth, Western Australia)

Day 1. Perth to Adelaide (D)

We collect you from home for your flight to Adelaide. Upon arrival, meet your local guide and transfer to the centrally located Majestic Roof Garden Hotel. Unwind from your journey before enjoying a relaxed welcome dinner.

Four nights: Peppers, Waymouth

Day 2. Adelaide Exploring (BD)

Explore the many plant collections in the Adelaide Botanical Gardens, from the Garden of Health and Mediterranean Garden to the award-winning Rose Garden. Perhaps discover what is housed in the various buildings and conservatories. Visit Carrick Hill, one of Australia's most intact period mansions that has been lovingly restored. Next you can enjoy the array of local product that South Australia is famous for at the Adelaide Markets. Follow this with a stop at the National Wine Centre to learn about the 65 wine regions of S.A. In the late afternoon venture to the beach side suburb of Glenelg where you can wander the pier for panoramic ocean views before dinner.

Day 3. Barossa Valley (BLD)

Today you will venture to the famous Barossa Valley. Admire the beautiful palm lined road leading into the Seppeltsfield Estate where you will take part in a Heritage Tour of this winery that was established in 1851. After, have some time to wonder the grounds, explore the Jam Factory gallery or try the Vasse Virgin products. Following this, you will be treated to a lunch at Maggie Beers. You will also have time to wonder her farm and browse her instore products. After this, call in at the Barossa Valley Chateau for a wine tasting and to wander the gardens.

Day 4. Free Day in Adelaide – Aida Opera (BD)

Today is your day to spend at your leisure. Perhaps visit the art gallery, take a cruise on the River Torrens, visit the impressive architectural space of the State Library or browse the shops on Rundle Street Mall. Meet for an early evening dinner before the highlight of your tour, the Aida Opera under the stars at the Adelaide Oval.

Day 5. Homeward Bound (B)

After breakfast you will be transferred to the Adelaide Airport for your flight to Perth. On arrival we will see you safely home.
