Your holiday itinerary (ex Perth, Western Australia)

Day 1. Perth to Bridgetown - Country Heritage and Charm (LD)

We collect you from home and transfer you to our coach. Travel to the arts hub of Pinjarra for morning tea at the Edenvale Heritage Precinct before touring through the Waroona Showgrounds murals and Harvey Dam. Pause at the replica Stirling Cottage, where you can admire the tranquil Harvey River and beautifully landscaped heritage gardens. Continue the journey to the rolling hills of Bridgetown and settle into your accommodation.

Day 2. Bridgetown Blooms and Local Treasures (BD)

Enjoy a peaceful morning among private gardens, complete with a relaxed morning tea and more floral discoveries. After lunch, step back into the town's history with a guided tour at the Bridgetown Historical Society, followed by a visit to the Bridgetown Jigsaw Gallery. Day 3. Gardens, Gourmet and Golden Valley (BLD)
