Day 1. Perth to Albany (D)

End your afternoon marvelling at the stunning natural beauty of The Gap and Natural Bridge, where dramatic rock formations and breathtaking ocean views merge.

Day 4. Op Shops and Antiques (BD)

Embark on a fascinating day of uncovering all Albany has on offer. Begin with a visit to Willyung Antiques & Car Collection, where you'll explore an impressive array of antiques and classic cars. Then, delve into the region's past at the Museum of the Great Southern, where interactive exhibits and historical displays provide a deeper understanding of Albany's significance.
