Day 3: Pemberton's Natural Wonders & Tramway (BD)

Begin your morning surrounded by the raw beauty of Beedelup Falls, followed by an awe-inspiring visit to the towering Dave Evans Bicentennial Tree, one of the tallest fire lookout trees in the world. Later, board the Pemberton Tram for a scenic railway journey through lush forests and historic timber country. Enjoy free time for lunch in Pemberton's charming town centre before discovering Pemberton Artscape, where local artists bring the landscape to life through unique forest-inspired balustrades. Cap off the day with a wine tasting at Hidden River Estate, savouring the region's finest selections.

Day 4: Pemberton to Perth (B)
