

A Note from our Pastor, Fr. Tom McMichael

As we reach the mid-point of our 40 day Lenten journey our Scripture readings and liturgies focus more and more on the Passion of our Lord Jesus. On Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord (March 24) and Good Friday (March 29) we come face to face with Jesus' terrible suffering and death but also the depth of God's love for us. These events—along with the Resurrection and Ascension that follow—are at the center of the mystery of God's saving work. St. Peter echoes the Prophet Isaiah when he writes of Christ's Passion "By his wounds you have been healed." [1 Peter 2:24]

I'm including a photo of a photo recently given to me by Immaculate Conception parishioners Diane and Scott Giles of the power-ful mosaic of the crown of thorns sprouting blossoms from the Church of the Flagellation, 2nd Station of the Cross, on the Via Dolorosa in Jerusalem. Pilgrims from the Skagit Valley parishes saw this on our 2020 pilgrimage to the Holy Land. I'm also including a photo of that pilgrimage group and our 2023 pilgrimage group. Please join me in praying for peace in the Holy Land, Ukraine, and in all war-torn parts of our world. Fr. Tom

Los peregrinos de las parroquias del Valle de Skagit vivieron esto en nuestra peregrinación a tierra santa en el 2020. 
