



A Note from our Pastor, Fr. Tom McMichael

"All I want to know is Christ and the power flowing from His Resurrection!"

— St. Francis of Assisi

Happy Easter and welcome to our Skagit Valley Catholic churches on this holy and festive Easter Sunday! Today we celebrate with fellow Catholics and Christians around the world the wondrous event at the very center of our faith—the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus. The accounts of all four evangelists—St. Matthew, St. Mark, St. Luke, and St. John are filled with mystery and suspense as they recount the amazement and surprise of Jesus' disciples on that first Easter morning. The Resurrection of Jesus from the dead is all about what God did, does, and will do for our good and the good of our world.

I especially lift up the many candidates and elect in Skagit Valley parishioners who are receiving Easter sacraments today and in the upcoming Easter season. These sacraments—literally "mysteries"—are God's gift to us and connect us here and now to the saving power of the risen Christ. We will continue to celebrate and experience what St. Francis of Assisi called the "power flowing from His Resurrection" for the coming 50 days of the Easter season. That power flowing from Jesus' Resurrection—God's grace received in Holy Baptism, Holy Eucharist, Confirmation, and the other sacraments—sustains and transforms us. 


