



Vacant Seat on the Boston Heights Village Council

The Village of Boston Heights has an open seat on Village Council following the recent resignation of a council member. Council will appoint a Village resident to serve a **four-year term ending December 31, 2029**.

Serving on Council is an opportunity to give back to the community, help guide Village decisions, and work alongside fellow residents to keep Boston Heights a great place to live.

How to Be Considered

Residents interested in being considered for appointment should submit:

- A **letter of interest**, and
- A **resume or brief statement** describing their experience and qualifications

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a **resident of the Village of Boston Heights**, and
- Have lived in the Village for **at least one year**.

Attend a Council Meeting

Interested residents are strongly encouraged to attend one or both upcoming Village Council meetings:

- **Tuesday, January 13, 2026 at 7:00 PM**
- **Tuesday, January 27, 2026 at 7:00 PM**

At the beginning of each meeting, interested residents will have an opportunity to briefly introduce themselves to Council and share information such as:

- Why you are interested in serving on Council
- How long you have lived in the Village
- Your background and work experience
- Community involvement or volunteer service
- Ideas for improving the Village
- Recent Village projects you have appreciated
- The strengths and perspective you would bring to Council

Compensation

Council members receive **\$3,000 per year (\$250.00 per month)** while serving the Village. Residents who care about Boston Heights and want to play a role in its future are encouraged to apply. Public service at the local level makes a real difference, and Council welcomes thoughtful, engaged community members who are willing to serve.

Council has until January 30, 2026 to appoint a new member of council.
