**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF  
CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT  
CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF BOSTON HEIGHTS,  
OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Boston Heights, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, numerous sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has entered into a contract to prepare and publish such revisions, which are now before Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL** of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Boston Heights, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to-wit:

**SECTION 3.** The Fiscal Officer, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.21, shall prepare and post a succinct summary of this Ordinance, which shall contain notice that the complete text of this Ordinance may be obtained or viewed, and the Codified Ordinances viewed, at the office of the Fiscal Officer and may be viewed at any other location designated by Council.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the 2025 Replacement Pages to the Boston Heights Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid legal entanglements, including conflict with general State law.
