**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 121.02(c)(1)(B) OF THE  
CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE ROADS  
COMMITTEE TO THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village’s Roads Committee has many responsibilities, including many beyond the construction, maintenance, and repair of the Village’s roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village’s Service Department was recently renamed the Public Works Department; and

**WHEREAS**, redesignating the Village’s Road Committee as the Village’s Public Works Committee is fitting and proper and in the best interest of the Village and its residents to rename the Road Committee as the Public Works Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Chapter 121.02(c)(1)(B) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Boston Heights be amended, with additions in **bold and underlined**, and deletions are ~~stricken and underlined~~, as follows:

B. ~~Roads Committee~~: **Public Works Committee**

**Section 2.** That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
