A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE SUMMIT COUNTY INTERGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING JOB CREATION AND RETENTION AND TAX REVENUE SHARING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Boston Heights is entering a new period of significant commercial development;

WHEREAS, the Village of Boston Heights desires to collaborate with the County of Summit and its political subdivisions in the fostering of economic growth for this region.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the most recent version of the Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
- <u>Section 2</u>. The authorizations herein only extend through the subject version of the Memorandum of Understanding. Should any revisions be made to the Memorandum of Understanding, the Village will no longer be a signatory unless prior authorization has been expressly granted by this Council and the Mayor has executed the same.
- **Section 3**. That the Recitals set forth above are hereby adopted and incorporated as findings in this Resolution.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 5.</u> That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the timely execution of the subject agreement and the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Village residents and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
