A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE BOND RETIREMENT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village’s Bond Retirement fund pays principal and interest for debt obligations of the Village of Boston Heights; and,

WHEREAS, the Village’s General Fund funds the Debt Service of the Village of Boston Heights; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That the Village Council desires to transfer the money from the General Fund to the Bond Retirement Fund.

Section 2: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$691,000.00 from the General Fund to the Bond Retirement Fund, as set forth herein.

Section 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action and were taken in the meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the Village residents, and to timely complete all relevant legal and reporting deadlines and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
