A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW AN EXISTING 2.75 MILL TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES (O.R.C. 5705.10(G)), AND REQUESTING THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THAT LEVY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to renew the 2.75 mill levy for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads, and bridges resurfacing and repairing of streets, roads, and bridges (O.R.C. 5705.19(G)); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (b) of Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Sections 5705.19 and 5705.191 of the Revised Code, this Council must request that the Summit County Fiscal Officer certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Revised Code authorizing its submission to the electors, and requesting such certification, the Summit County Fiscal Officer is to certify the total current tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council declares it is necessary to renew, for five years, all of an existing 2.75-mill ad valorem tax outside of the ten-mill limitation to be levied upon the entire territory of the Village of Boston Heights, which is located entirely within the County of Summit, for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads, and bridges resurfacing and repairing of streets, roads, and bridges (O.R.C. 5705.19(G)), and that it intends to submit the question of that renewal in the form of a ballot measure, with said taxes to be first levied in the year 2027 and first collected in the year 2028, to the electors within the entire territory of the Village of Boston Heights at an election on November 3, 2026, as authorized by Section 5705.19 and 5705.191 and pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. This Council requests the Summit County Fiscal Officer to certify to it both (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the 2.75-mill renewal.

Section 3. The Village Fiscal Officer is directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Summit County Fiscal Officer.

Section 4. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 5. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law

Section 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to submit this certification to the Summit County Fiscal Office so the process and necessary paperwork can be completed in time pursuant to law; wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
