A RESOLUTION CONVERTING A PORTION OF AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT FUND AND RETURNING THE REMAINDER TO THE GENERAL FUND AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village’s Safety Intervention Grant fund accounted for the receipts and disbursements relating to the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation to the Village of Boston Heights for safety equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the Village was responsible for paying the entire cost of the safety equipment up front, therefore, it was necessary to advance the grants portion of the safety equipment from the General Fund to the Safety Intervention Grant Fund until such time the Safety Intervention Grant moneys were released; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: The safety equipment was purchased, and a reimbursement will be made to the General Fund, and the Fiscal Officer requests Council’s approval to convert a portion of the advance to the Fund as a transfer.

Section 2: This Council authorizes and directs the Fiscal Officer to note on the official records and books of the Village of Boston Heights, that the previously approved advance by Resolution 2024-1-4 in the amount of \$23,453.05 from the General Fund shall now treat \$9,196.95 as a transfer from the General Fund to the Safety Intervention Grant Fund and reimburse the General Fund \$14,256.10.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the Village residents, and to timely complete all relevant legal and reporting deadlines and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.


