A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OHM ADVISORS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE AKRON PENINSULA ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Boston Heights has identified the need for roadway improvements on Akron Peninsula Road from Camp Ledgewood to the western corporation limits of the Village; and

WHEREAS, OHM Advisors is willing to provide related professional services for the consideration upon the terms and conditions of an agreement, substantially similar to the one attached hereto as Exhibit “A;” and

WHEREAS, Council finds it necessary and in the best interest of the Village to retain OHM Advisors to provide the professional services described in its Proposal No. 25106.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with OHM Advisors for professional services associated with the Akron Peninsula Road Improvements Project in accordance with Proposal No. 25106, dated June 3, 2026, in an amount not to exceed Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00).

Section 2. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to effectuate the entering of, execution, and implementation of said agreement.


Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

Section 5. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village residents, to allow for the timely, cost-effective construction of infrastructure within the Village during ongoing work and during good weather, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village administration and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.


