**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio:

Section 1: That it is necessary to amend the Annual Appropriations, for the Village of Boston Heights for the year ending December 31, 2026.

Section 2: Amended Appropriations. This council amends the following sums for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026 for the various funds of the Village, as follows:

GENERAL FUND

Transfers Out \$3,500,000.00

STREET CONSTRUCTION/MAINTENANCE

Other \$ 204,054.00

Section 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action and were taken in the meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirement including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village, and the daily operations of the Village's various departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
