


## How to Measure a Belt



- Using your favorite belt:
  - Measure from the buckle reach to the hole you are currently using in inches.
- Using your regular pants:
  - Take a sewing tape and measure (in inches) your waist where you would normally wear your pants.
- Don't have a sewing tape?
  - Take a piece of string/yarn, measure your waist where you would normally wear your pants, mark the cut off, measure the string/yarn with a measuring tape (in inches).
- Notes:
  - Using pant sizes does not accurately measure your waist as sizing is inconsistent between brands.
  - Waist size is usually 2-5" larger than your actual pant size.
  - o Buckle Reach is measured at the inside of the end of the buckle bar.
  - Please use inches for consistency.
  - Measure at your current belt hole, which will allow us to place holes for you to size up or down.
