


## How to Measure a Dog Collar



- Using your dog's current collar:
  - Measure (in inches) from the end of material at the buckle end to the hole the collar is currently using.
- Using a sewing tape:
  - Take a sewing tape and measure (in inches) your dog's neck where the collar would normally sit/rest.
- Don't have a sewing tape?
  - Take a piece of string/yarn, measure your dog's neck where the collar would normally sit/rest, mark the cut off, measure the string/yarn with a measuring tape (in inches).
- Notes:
  - When measuring your dog's neck, make sure the sewing tape is snug, but not too tight.
  - General guideline is that you should be able to comfortably fit two fingers between the measuring tape and the dog's neck.
  - Please use inches for consistency.
  - Measure at the current collar hole, which will allow us to place holes for you to size the collar up or down.

Dog Collar Sizing Guide			
Collar Size	Neck Size (in)	Width of Collar (in)	Examples
Extra Small	8-12"	5/8"	Chihuahua, Pomeranian, Yorkshire Terrier
Small	10-14"	5/8"	Boston Terrier, Dachshund, Cavalier King Charles Spaniel
Medium	12-18"	3/4"	Border Collie, Basset Hound, Cocker Spaniel
Large	16-26"	1"	Labrador Retrievers, Standard Poodle
Extra Large	24-30"	1" to 2"	Bernese Mountain Dog, Great Dane, St. Benard
